

- Computer: High speed DSL is up and running; memory has been upgraded and we can now print directly to copier. Quick books has been upgraded to current edition (had not been upgraded for 5 years). We now have a computer on the volunteer desk so they can look up meetings on the web.
 - Need volunteers for office – lots of shift options.
 - Need 12 step-call volunteers. Current list is out of date so even if you think you're on it, make sure your info is current. One year sobriety is preferred for both volunteer jobs.
 - Groupvines – lots of waste with stacks not being picked up and groups not distributing all they have. Let Jim know if you could do with fewer copies.
 - The Grapevine can now be downloaded from the web, www.aagrapevine.org in MP-3 format. GSR's have a code that will allow you to have 1 month free and after that, there is an annual subscription fee.
 - Last Saturday, inventory for Central Office was completed: the count included 762 sobriety cards; 7,415 medallions; 31,916 books and literature.
- 7.. **SPECIAL EVENTS:** Bill B. In Bill's absence, Jerald reported that information and committee meetings for the Gratitude Dinner will begin after Maad Dog Daze.
8. **OUTREACH COMMITTEE:** Ginny P. asked reps to let her know if there is any meeting without an Intergroup rep and she will visit that meeting. Also, anyone can at anytime recommend to the group that they should have representation and why. Questions from the floor: 1) "what do we do with reps who just stop coming?" Intergroup itself takes no specific action. However, you can encourage that person to come or suggest to the group to get a new one. 2) How long is the Intergroup commitment?" One year is recommended so that the rep can be in a position to run for the board. (GSR is recommended to be a 2 year commitment). A rep must attend at least 6 Intergroup meetings and be at the December meeting when election is held. The sobriety requirement to be on the board is 3 years.
9. **WEBMASTER:** Jim K. reported that the total number of hits for the month was 32,819. In one day there were 83 ½ sessions and 3,003 hits. The new record for number of sessions in one day was 102. A session is a visit or, accessing the site. A hit is going to different pages within the site after access. There were 75 visits to the June Groupvine. The meeting list has been converted to a data base with one page for cities and one page for days of the week making it easier and quicker to update. More user friendly improvements are coming. Anything you want to see on the web site, contact Jim and let him know via email. Jim gave clarification that the Groupvine (our local newsletter) is already available on the web site and the Grapevine (AA World Service's publication) is now available in MP-3 format.
- 10 **OLD BUSINESS:** Carol reminded everyone to double check the info on the typed sign in sheet for errors. Also, on the "new rep" sign-in sheet, please make sure it is legible.
11. **NEW BUSINESS:** Sign-up sheet for volunteers to cover the Central Office literature table at Maad Dog Daze is going around. Please consider taking at least one 2-hour shift.

12. **GROUP REPRESENTATIVES - COMMENTS AND/OR CONCERNS:**
- An announcement was made as a reminder that Unity Day picnic is Sunday July 16th at Hurkey Creek. This year's event is being hosted by H&I. Proceeds are divided three ways to benefit Central Office, District 9 (GSR) and H&I.
 - Groupvines not picked up. One suggestion was made that the volunteers could call meeting reps that haven't picked up their Groupvines. Another suggestion was for Ginny to take unclaimed Groupvines as an aid in knowing what meetings need a visit from her and that she might even be able to deliver them.
 - New reps were reminded to pick up the Groupvines for their meeting. The name of meeting is on the top of each stack.
13. **H&I/G.S. Dist. 9/ PI and CPC REPORTS:** None. PI and CPC will be functions of GS Dist. 9 from now on. Jim K. will continue to chair the PI committee through District 9.
